Program Information

MISSION STATEMENT:

OBJECTIVES:

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

1. Provided a safe, supportive and caring environment.
2. Equal access to all program equipment, materials and facilities.
3. Discipline that is fair and consistent. **Students are expected to behave with the same rules that apply during the regular school day** as outlined in the student handbook.
4. Treated fairly by staff and peers.
5. Students must participate at least one day a week and 30 days over the course of the school year.

PARENT EXPECTATIONS:

1. Able to address concerns related to their student or the program.
2. Informed about positive and negative behaviors of their student.
3. Regularly informed about program activities.
4. Welcome to visit and audit the program at any time.
5. Review communication from the Program Director, i.e. newsletter, mailings, calendars etc.
6. Review handbook with student.

The Agoge expects that the student will:

- Be responsible for their actions.
- Abide by school rules and program rules at all times.
- Respect staff, mentors, and equipment.
- Remain in their designated area until released.
- Check in at 2:45PM and not leave school at any time between 2:45 and 5PM **unless a parent or guardian has contacted the program director and asked for early release**, i.e. student has a part-time after school job or other commitments.
- Take care of materials and equipment and return to proper place when done.
- Electronic devices will be turned off and put away during the after school program unless permission from mentor is been granted and the device is being used for homework research purposes.
- Be responsible for their personal property: The Agoge assumes no liability for lost items.
