## **Smart Goals:**

SMART Goal #1 By the Spring of 2020 80 % of our students will score a 3 or 4 on the Spring DMA. By the Spring of 2020 60% of our students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> will score proficient or higher on the Math ISAT.

SMART Goal #2 By the Spring of 2020 65% of our students will score a 3 or 4 on the DWA. 60% of the students K-6 scored proficient or higher on the 2019 Spring DWA. By the Spring of 2020 60% of our students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> will score proficient or higher on the ELA ISAT.
